AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND CHAPTER 151, KNOWN AS 'FEES', OF ORDINANCE NO. 1646, CHANGING, DELETING, AND/OR ADDING CERTAIN FEES AND/OR LANGUAGE FOR CITY SERVICES IN VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Greensburg to amend Chapter 151 of Ordinance No. 1646 as follows:

Excepted from this definition are those selling goods for charitable purposes and selling food items that they have farmed or otherwise created.

Article II Impounded Vehicles

§ 151-2 Daily fee.

The storage and impounding of any vehicle, as authorized by the Chief of Police, on City property will incur a fee of \$10 per day against the owner or owners of said vehicle for each day that the vehicle remains on City property.
