AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR CITY PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City of Greensburg, in Council assembled as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority contained in the Home Rule Charter, Article XIV, Section 70, the taxes hereafter set forth are hereby levied on all persons and property within said City subject to taxation for City purposes, for the year 2024:

- a. For general revenue purposes, the sum of 19.05 Mills, of assessed valuation of all real estate; and
- b. For debt purposes, the sum of 6.0 Mills, of assessed valuation of all real estate, making a total of Twenty-five and five hundredths (25.05) Mills, or the sum of Two Dollars and Five Hundred Five Thousandths (2.505) Cents on One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation of all real estate.
- c. For Library Funding, the sum of 1.0 Mills, of assessed valuation of all real estate, making a total of Twenty-six and five hundredths (26.05) Mills, or the sum of Two Dollars and Six Hundred Five Thousandths (2.605) Cents on One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation of all real estate.
- d. For Public Safety Funding, the sum of 1.0 Mills, of assessed valuation of all real estate, making a total of Twenty-seven and five hundredths (27.05) Mills, or the sum of Two Dollars and Seven Hundred Five Thousandths (2.705) Cents on One Hundred Dollars of assessed valuation of all real estate.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of January 2024.
