AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROPRIATING SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT HEREINAFTER SET FORTH DURING THE YEAR 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the City of Greensburg, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania as follows:
