AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND CHAPTER 151, KNOWN AS 'FEES', ~~OR OF~~ ORDINANCE NO. 1646, CHANGING, DELETING, AND/OR ADDING CERTAIN FEES AND/OR LANGUAGE FOR CITY SERVICES IN VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Greensburg to amend Chapter 151 of Ordinance No. 1646 as follows:

Peddling" is defined as the selling or offering for sale of any goods, wares, services or merchandise for immediate delivery, which goods, wares, services or merchandise the person selling or offering for sale carries with him in traveling or has in his possession or control upon any of the streets or sidewalks, from house to house, by visitation to private residences or by entering in or upon private property within the City. Excepted from this definition are those selling goods for charitable purposes and selling food items that they have farmed or otherwise

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Fee

"Soliciting" is defined as the seeking or taking of contracts or orders for any goods, wares, services or merchandise for future delivery or for subscriptions or contributions, upon any of the streets or sidewalks or from house to house or by visitation to private residences or by entering in or upon private property within the City. It further means the seeking or taking of contracts or orders for home or other building repair, improvement and alteration and also orders or contracts for any mechanical, electrical, plumbing or heating device or equipment for house or other building improvement or repair upon or from the places aforesaid within the City. Excepted from this definition are those selling goods for charitable purposes and selling food items that they have farmed or otherwise created.

Article II Impounded Vehicles

§ 151-2 Daily fee.

The storage and impounding of any vehicle, as authorized by the Chief of Police, on City property will incur a fee of \$10 per day against the owner or owners of said vehicle for each day that the vehicle remains on City property. This fee will be additional to any fees charged by the approved hauler of the impounded vehicle.

Compliance bonds

- A. Compliance bonds shall become the property of the City of Greensburg if one or more of the following occur during the building permit process:
- (1) The applicant fails to contact the City of Greensburg within six months regarding a final inspection and/or certificate of occupancy and/or status of the construction project. The building permit will be considered null and void in one year from the date of issuance, and therefore, the compliance bond will become the property of the City.
 - (2) Occupancy or use before final inspection and issuance of applicable certifications.
 - (3) Failure to complete landscaping requirements within a six-month period from the date of issuance of the permit.
 - (4) Failure to complete the project as per the plans submitted with the building permit application.
 - (5) Failure to complete the project as per all city codes, e.g., Uniform Construction Codes, zoning, property maintenance, etc.
- B. Any compliance bond issued prior to January 1, 1997, is hereby deemed the property of the City of Greensburg due to one or all of the above-mentioned reasons.


